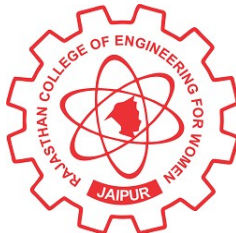

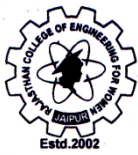

2. Exhibition:

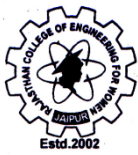
- An exhibition was organized showcasing photographs, models, and posters of UNESCO World Heritage Sites in India and around the world.

6. **Panel Discussion:**

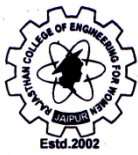
